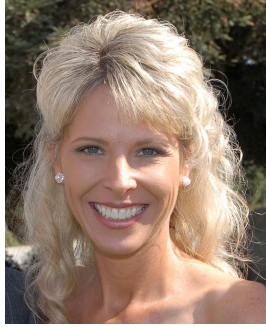


Nominee, 2nd Vice President
